Lesser Sabbats

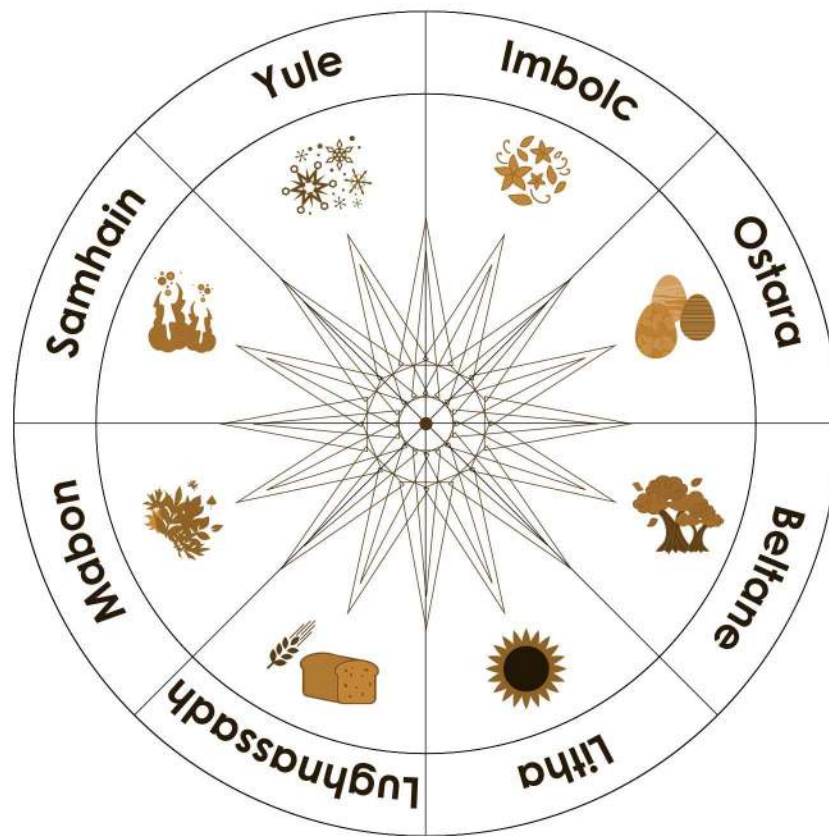
These represent the astronomical beginnings of the seasons.
Their dates may vary by a day or two each year.

Ostara (September 21st) also known as: **The Spring Equinox**

Litha (December 21st) also known as: **The Summer Solstice**

Mabon (March 21st) also known as: **The Autumn Equinox**

Yule (June 21st) also known as: **The Winter Solstice**



Greater Sabbats

Also known as Cross Quarter days or Fire Sabbats, they divide the time between a solstice and an equinox.

Imbolc (August 1st) also known as: **Oimeic / Candlemas**

Beltane (October 31st) also known as: **Roodmas / Walpurgis Night**

Lughnasadh (February 2nd) also known as: **Lammas**

Samhain (April 30th/May 1st) also known as: **Hallowmas / Halloween**
