Samhain October 31 / November 1	Cernunnos, Hecate, Persephone	Ancestral communication, divination, honoring the dead, letting go
Yule December 20-23 (Winter Solstice)	Sun God, Holly King	Rebirth, renewal, celebrating the return of the sun, introspection
Imbolc February 1-2 (Midwinter)	Brigid, Cerridwen	Purification, inspiration, beginnings, healing, honoring the hearth
Ostara March 20-23 (Spring Equinox)	Ostara, Eostre	Fertility, growth, rebirth, balance, celebrating the return of spring
Beltane April 30 / May 1 (May Day)	Cernunnos, May Queen	Fertility, union, passion, abundance, celebrating the peak of spring
Litha June 20-23 (Summer Solstice)	Sun God, Oak King	Abundance, strength, vitality, celebrating the height of summer
Lammas August 1-2 (Lughnasadh)	Lugh, Demeter	Harvest, abundance, gratitude, honoring the cycle of life and death
Mabon September 20-23 (Autumn Equinox)	Mabon, Persephone	Balance, gratitude, introspection, celebrating the harvest and the approaching darkness
