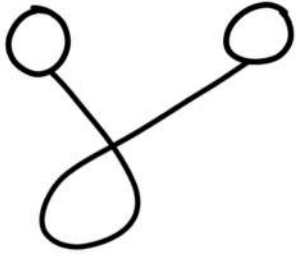


Symbols for Intuition

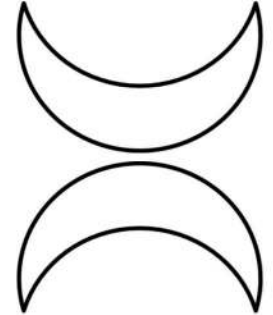


Water of Life

From Basil Valentine in the 17th century. Water is a symbol of the subconscious mind and intuition, due to its flowing, formless, and reflective nature. Water as an element is traditionally associated with the emotional, psychic, and intuitive realms.

Luna Fixa

In alchemy, Luna Fixa symbolizes the purification and stabilization of feminine, lunar qualities, representing a process of integrating and harmonizing and subconscious aspects within a balanced, unified state. This bond is symbolized by the Moon's influence over tides, its rhythmic fluidity and transformative qualities.

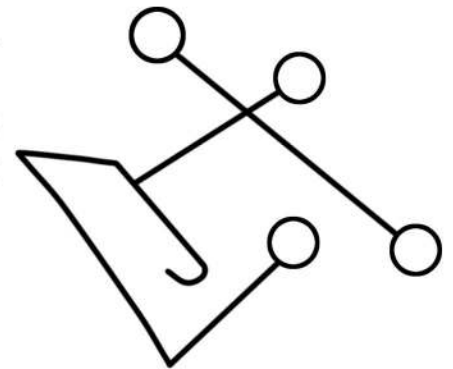


Archangel Gabriel's Sigil

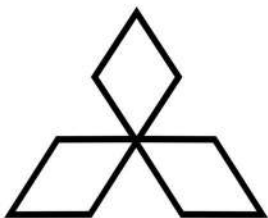
Gabriel rules over the Moon, which aligns with his role as a revealer of mysteries and hidden knowledge.

Intelligence of Moon

In Agrippa's esoteric system and similar traditions, this concept refers to a unique spiritual entity that embodies the Moon's essence, encompassing emotions, intuition, the subconscious, psychic abilities, and feminine energy. The Moon sigil is specifically crafted to encapsulate and invoke these lunar qualities.



Triceps Rune



It is a symbol from Norse and Germanic rune traditions, comprising a three-part design. The triceps rune, with its threefold structure, might symbolize concepts such as creation, preservation, and destruction, or other triadic concepts like past, present, and future.

Water Triplicity Sigil

Recorded by Agrippa in 1510, it unifies the three water signs: Cancer, Scorpio, and Pisces. It represents their shared traits: emotional depth, intuition, sensitivity, and their connection.
